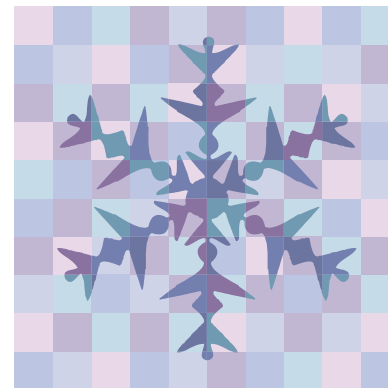

February 20—Monthly meeting at the Racquet Club—same bat time, same bat channel.

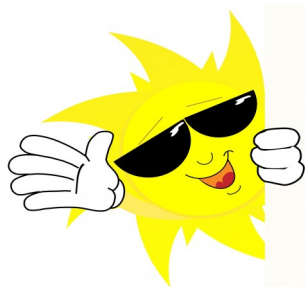
