#### February Charity: Lexington Rescue Mission

We are continuing our January Charity into February since we got a late start last month. The charity is the Lexington Rescue Mission which is one of our old charities that we haven't supported recently. Sorry for repeating myself this month but here's what they need!!.

There are several options for you to participate. They now are providing meals so you can donate food to The Outreach Center. The items they most need are spaghetti, pasta sauce, diced canned tomatoes, canned corn, green beans, peas and carrots, peanut butter, individual packages of cheese or peanut butter crackers, lemonade mix, coffee, sugar and creamer. They can also use fresh fruits and vegetables, frozen meat, and eggs.

Since winter is here they can also use: Sleeping bags, Small Tents, Lextran bus passes (30-day passes most needed), Laundry detergent, Hats and gloves, Dishwashing liquid, Gas cards, Cleaning products, Pillows, Bath towels and wash cloths.

Of Course... cash is always helpful!!

We used to collect toiletries for them as well... If you got, bring em... I'm sure they can find a use for them!!
